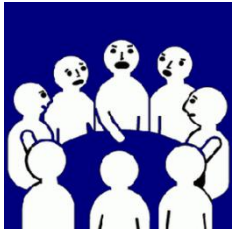

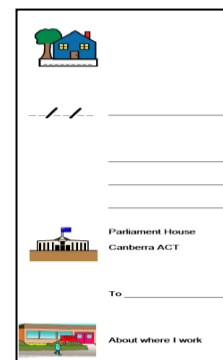
Requirements for this course:
