We respect each person.



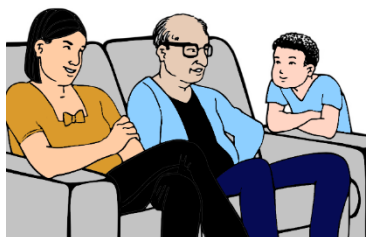
Each person is different.

We help you to feel safe. Like train our staff

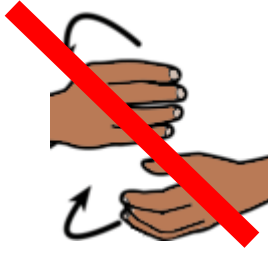
- about different help you need

They can help you go to these places.

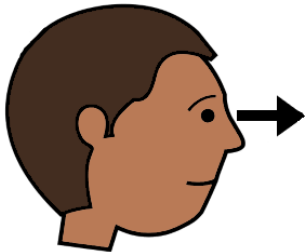


Some times you do **not** feel safe.

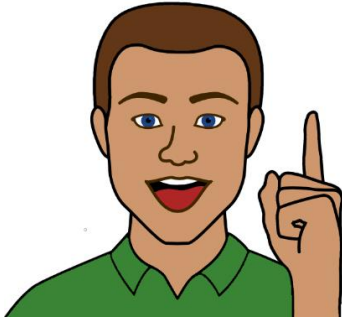
It may be **no** staff use sign language.

**And**

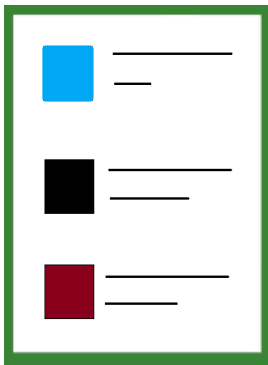


We have a bus for your wheel chair.



We tell you things in a way you can

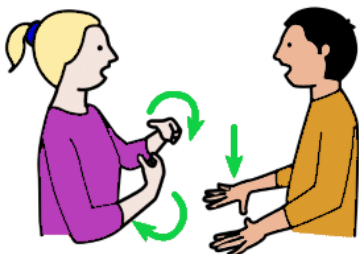
- read

- in your language.



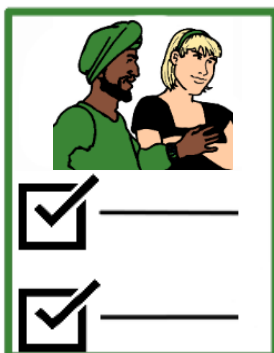
## What we will do

They keep staff safe.

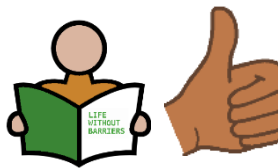
