You learn on the job

You are called an

- Apprentice;
- **or**
- Trainee.

The government will help with your pay.

What do you need to do?

Your boss needs to do some paperwork.

Can my work get this money?

Your boss may get help for half your pay.

It will be for your work from 1 January 2020 to 30 September 2020.

And

Your work has **less** than 20 people in it.

You were working there on 1 March 2020

or

You had to get a new place to work this year. There was no work at your old job.

Your boss talks to their Australian Apprenticeship Support Network person.

When can the boss do this?

Your boss can start the paperwork now.

But

All paper work must be done by 31 December 2020.
