- Follow these new rules.

## New rules in Australia. After 25 March 2020

There are **more** new rules in Australia. It is to slow down COVID-19. These rules are as well as the rules in Step 1 Lockdown. Read the fact sheet **What is shut? Australia. Step 1**

### Space between us

This **must** be **all the time**. This space must be 2 big steps every way you look. Read the posters **We have space between us**.

## Step 2 Lockdown

### Stay at home

Only go out to

- Buy food;
- To pick up take away;
- **or**
- Go to the doctor;
- Care for another person;
- **or**
- Go to work.

You can go for a walk or run. It must be

- In your local area;
- By yourself;
- **or**
- In a small group.

Do **not** do things with lots of other people at home. Like

- do **not** have a BBQ with all your family;
- do **not** have a birthday party;
- do **not** have a house party.

### Work

Work from home when you can.

Who is a **needed** worker? This is also called an **essential** worker. It is anyone with a job.

## Groups

### Outside

It must be **less than** 10 people. Everyone must have their space.

### Inside

Everyone must have their space. Like In a fish and chip shop

- 2 customers
  - 2 staff
- and**
- 1 staff out the back.

## All these places are closed too.

Food courts in shopping centres. **But**, you can buy take away from them.

Outdoor markets.

Indoor markets.

Each state may have different rules. Read the fact sheet for your state.

### But

Food markets will be open. Like Flemington market.

## These are closed too

Places you go for beauty service. Like

- Beauty shop;
- Tan;
- Wax;
- Nails;
- Spa and massage parlours.

### And

- Tattoo shops.

### But

- Hairdressers will be open.
- Barbers will be open.

## These are closed too

Theatres.  
Concert halls.  
Large public places.

Libraries.  
Youth Centres  
Clubs. Like RSL  
Community Centres

Amusement parks.  
Arcade games shop.  
Indoor play centres.  
Outdoor play centre.

Swimming pools.  
Social sport. Like a group in the park.

Sauna  
Bathhouse  
Wellness centres

Health clubs.  
Fitness clubs.  
Yoga centres.  
Barre classes.  
Spin clubs.

### **But**

Boot camps are OK. It must be a small group. Personal training is OK.

**Remember.** Have space for everyone.

## These are closed too

Galleries.  
Museums.  
National places. Like War Memorials.

On Anzac Day there will be

- **No** ANZAC day marches;
- **No** public ANZAC day services.

Live house auctions. You will need to meet with the agent.

There will be **no** Open for Inspections.

Places that sell used things. Like furniture. These are called Auction Houses.

## Weddings

Only the 2 people.

**and**

The person who marries them with 2 people to witness. **No** party after the wedding.

## Funerals

It must be less than 10 people. Do **not** meet in a group after the funeral.

## Travel outside Australia

You can **not** travel out of Australia. Only some people can do this. Like

- you need to go for work;
- or**
- you can ask to go to family when
    - they are very sick;
    - when they die. You may be able to go.

**But**

COVID-19 is all over the world. Most countries will say **no** to you coming.

There will be **more** new rules. Each state may also have more rules.
