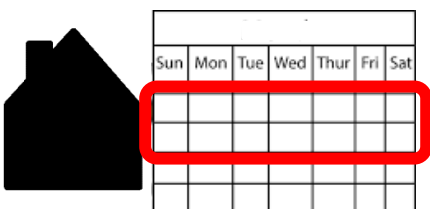


There are rules about this.

You can come to South Australia.

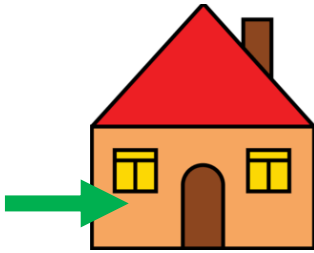
But

You live in South Australia.

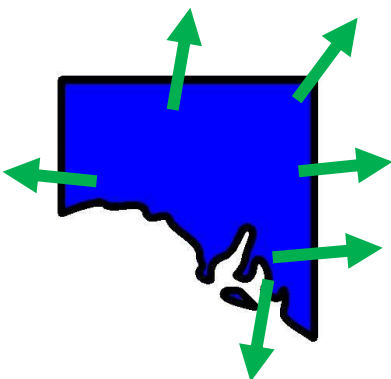


Go to your own home.

You must stay there for 2 weeks.

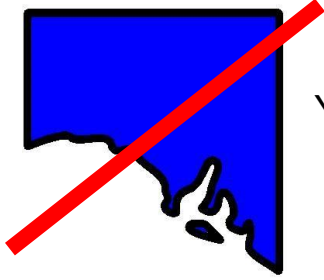
It is the same as 14 days.

You do **not** live in South Australia.



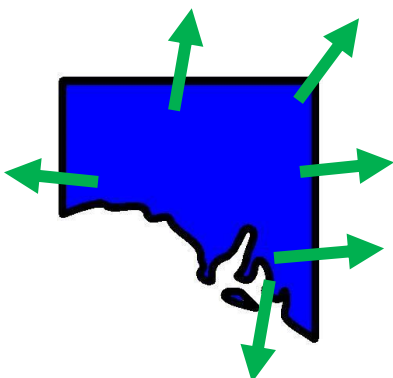
You will stay in a hotel.

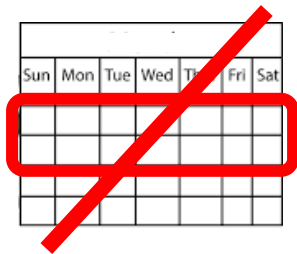
It is the same as 14 days.

Some people do **not** need to stay in the 1 place.



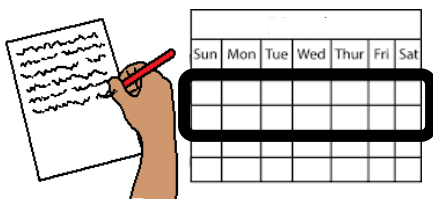
It is for people like some one that

- is an ambulance driver



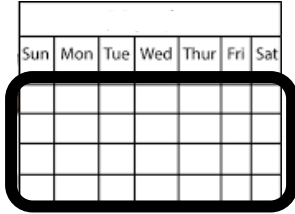
- is a truck driver. It has food for shops

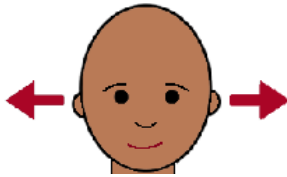


You must write down every one you see.

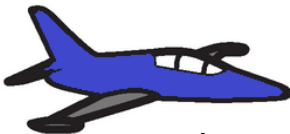
Do this for 2 weeks.

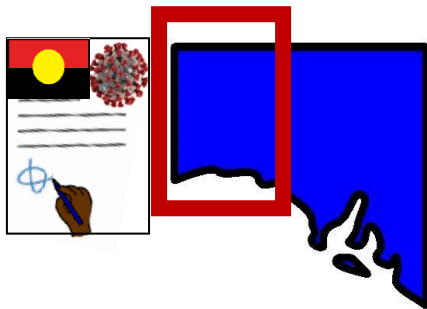

- Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Lands.

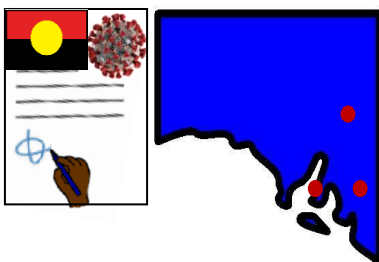
They are also called the **APY** Lands

and

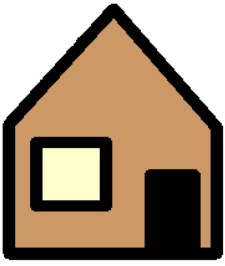


- Nepabunna excluding Iga Warta.

- Gerard. This is also called Riverland.

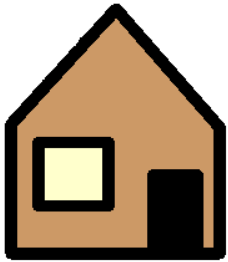


There are only some reasons you can go there.

- you need to drive through. It is the only way to your place. You can **not** stop.

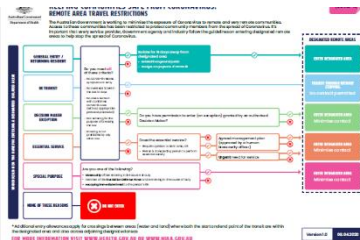
