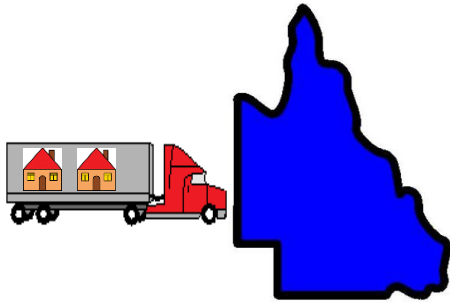


There are only **3** things you can come for.

2. You do **not** live in Queensland.

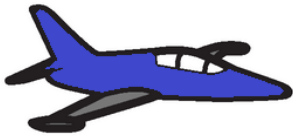


Your job is

You are a FIFO worker.

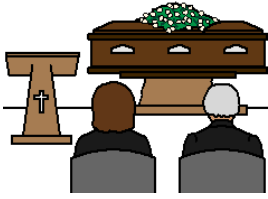


- police

- work on fishing boats.

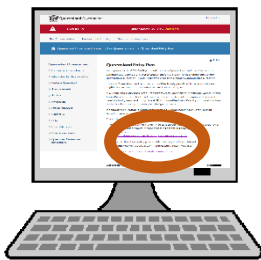


Other people can ask to come to Queensland. Like

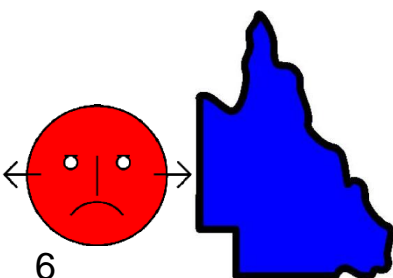
- you want to come to a funeral

3. You have come to start a new job.



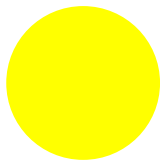
You need to get a Queensland Entry Pass
