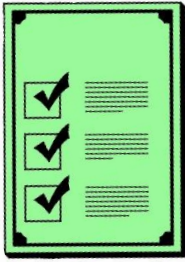

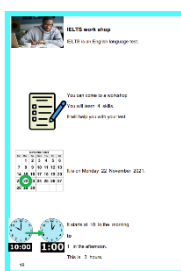

Award Finalist

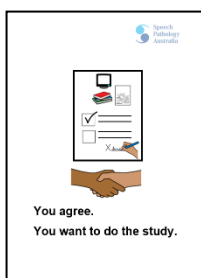
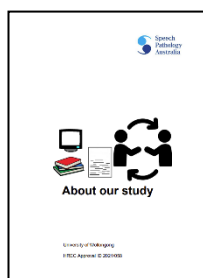
