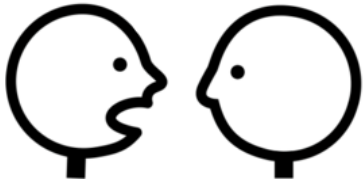


We write a report.

It may be

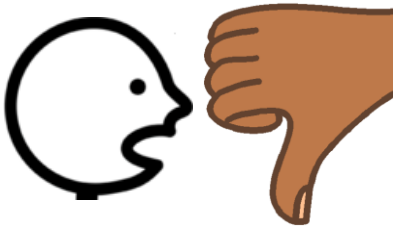
- you

- in a service

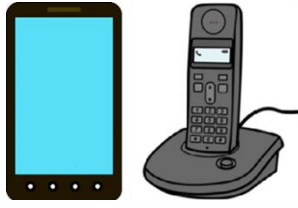
or
