We gave money to local groups.

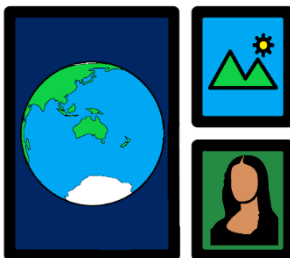
Here are some things they did.

This year we did lots of big projects.

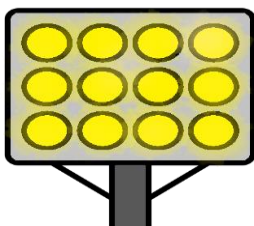


Eltham North Dog Park. It is a new park.

Coventry Oval. It is in Diamond Creek.



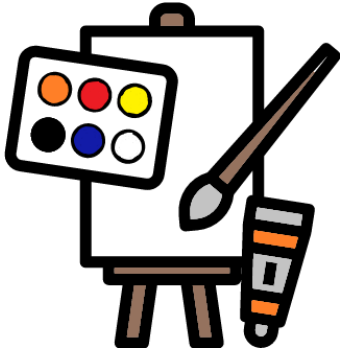
We put in new lights.

- help to get a covid test.



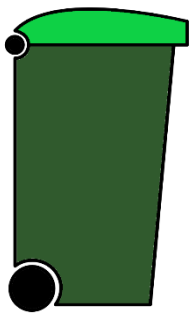
We looked after the places you can go. Like the

There is a mobile library. It is in a truck.

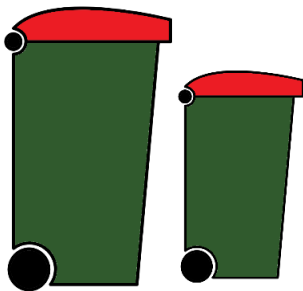
It goes to lots of places.

- how our staff help you.



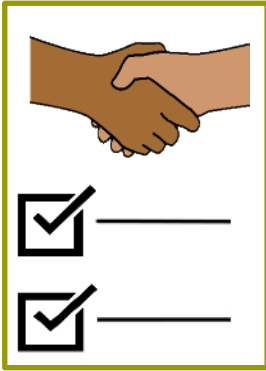
We helped young people learn to drive.

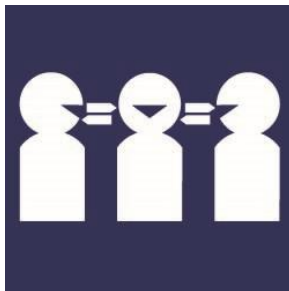

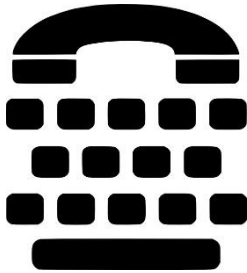
