It is at Rymill Park.



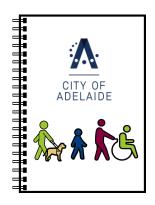
We built new toilets. They have

We will make a quiet space in buildings.

They can build a new ramp.



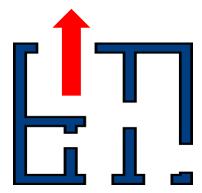
You go to a council place. Like a library.

You can hear an alarm.

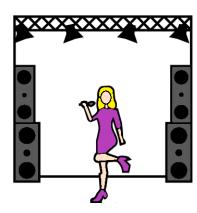

- Adelaide Fringe.



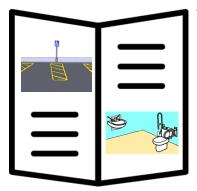
You can come to Christmas in the city.

We will tell you about each event. Like

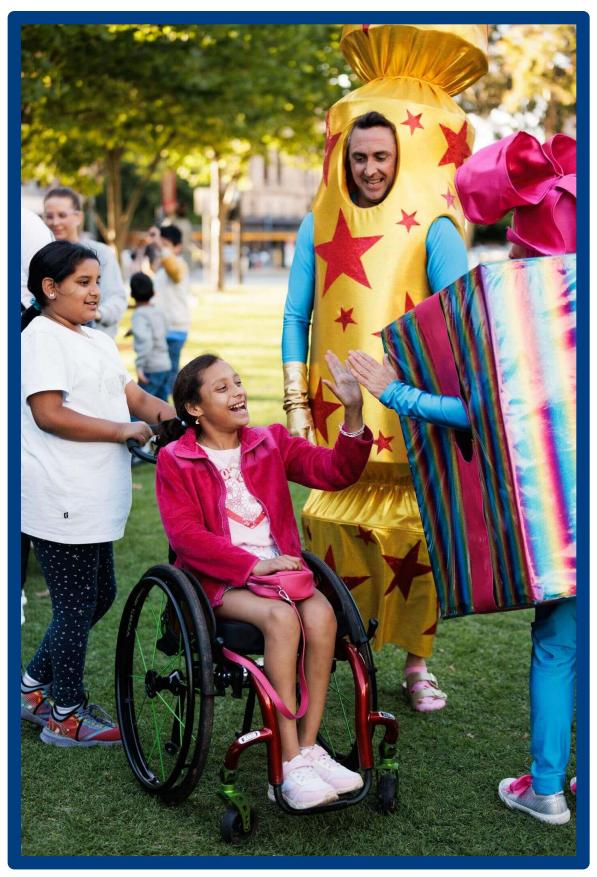
- where you can park

Goal 5.

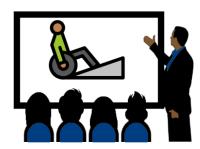
We listen to you.
