- your doctor
- people who help you.



QCAT makes a choice. They may say yes.

You can look after your money.

Or



They say no. You can **not** look after your money.



QCAT says you need help.

A person will make money choices for you.

QCAT chooses the person.



It may be a person you know. Like

- your dad
- your wife.



It may be a different person. It is their job.

It may be the Public Trustee.



QCAT calls them your financial administrator.

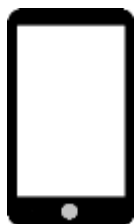
