Senator Jenny McAllister



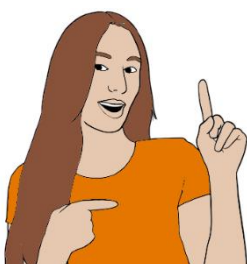
Jenny is part of the government.

Natalie is a lawyer.

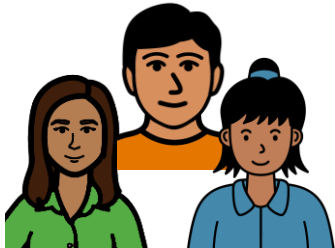
She speaks up for all people with disabilities.

Mary Sayers

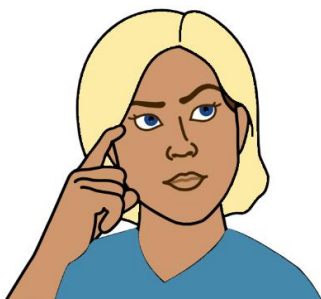


Mary is our boss. We call her the CEO.
