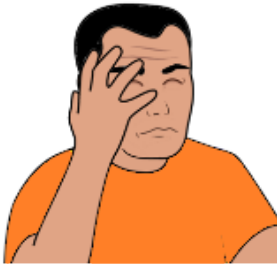


You need to pay back money.

A person in your family needs your help.

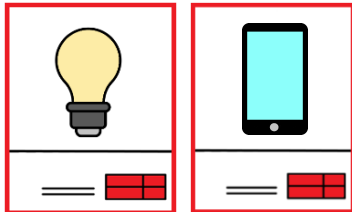
You can **not** work

You tell us what happened.



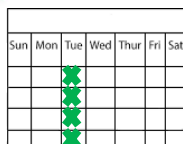
We may let you

We **may** say you can pay less money.

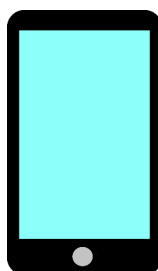
Like you can pay just \$ 600.

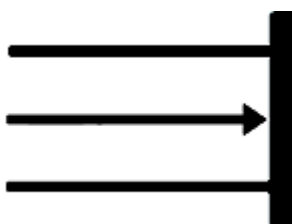

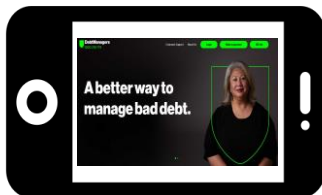
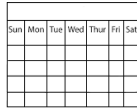
