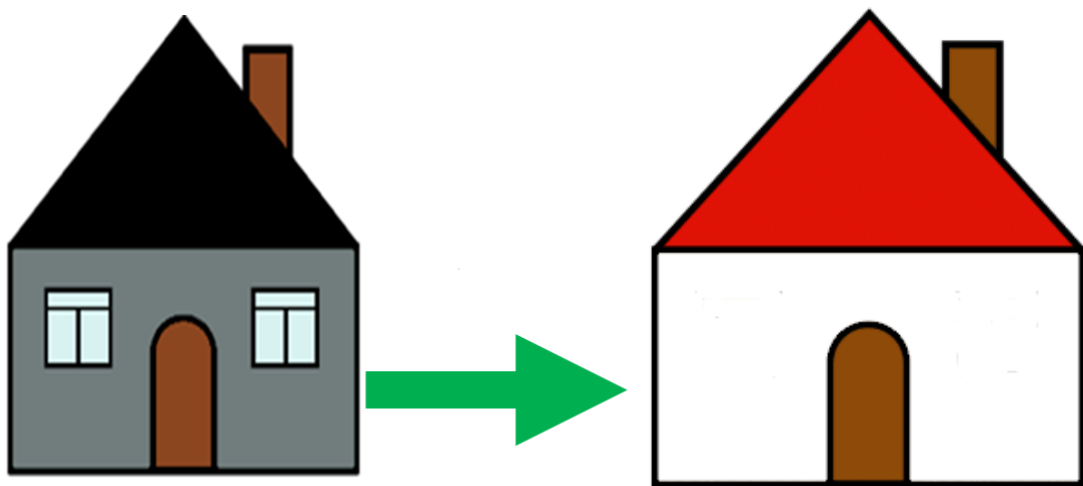


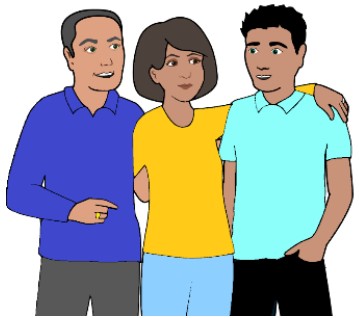

You may live with your family.

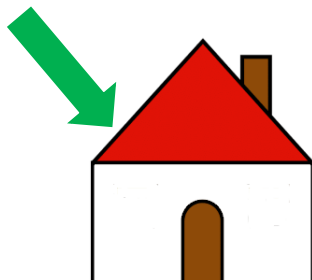
You may live with other people. Like

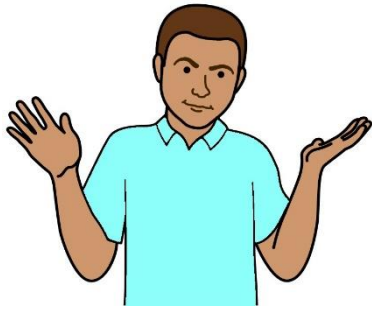
- your mum

What can you do?



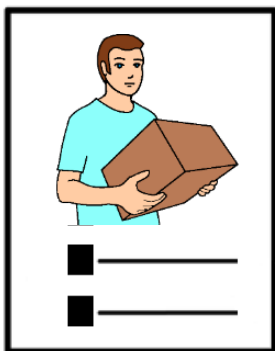
There are things to think about. Like

You write a plan.



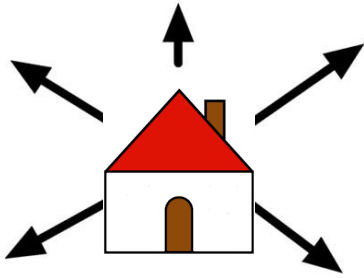
You can ask people to help you. Like

Like in the country.

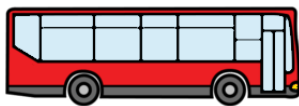

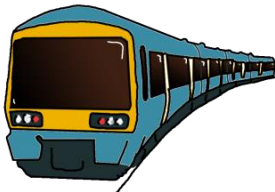


Think about how you will get to places. Like

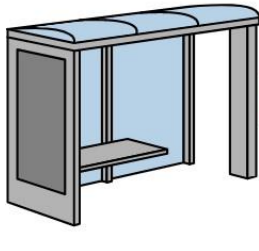
- your work

You may get a

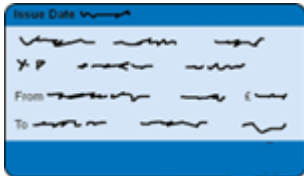


- bus

- your partner.



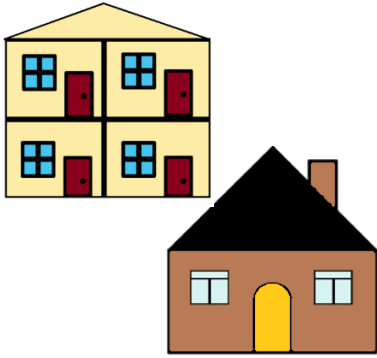
You may choose to live with your pet.

- like the same food?

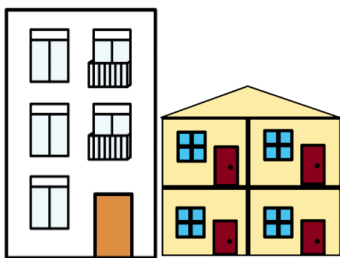


What home will you choose?

- in a unit



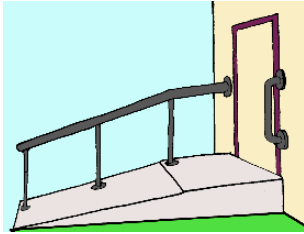
- in a place with a lot of land. Like a farm.



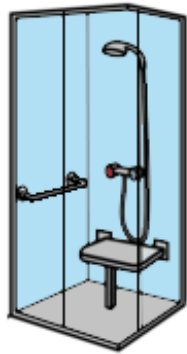
Do you want a garden?



Do you need space for friends to visit?



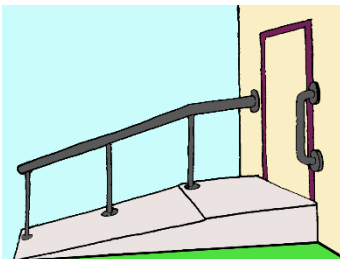
What will you need at home?

- rails in your shower

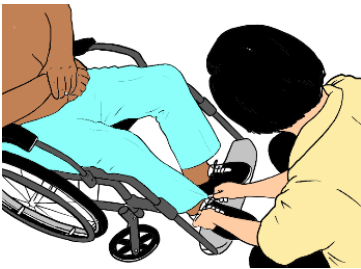


- ramps

Like help to cook at home.



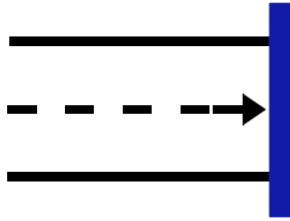
You may need help to do things Like

- shower.

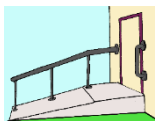
